

## 1. Bill of Lading

Please write your tax bond number or <u>tax-exempt identification</u> on the BOL.

## 2. Commercial Invoice

Although shipments to Puerto Rico don't need to clear customs, they are subject to excise/sales tax based on the value of the goods (noted in the commercial invoice).

Keep in mind that because Puerto Rico is a territory of the U.S., there are no Customs and Border Protection formalities involved in trade or travel between the U.S. mainland and Puerto Rico.
